<b>Serve</b>	<p><b>SPAN 4156 and 4157 – Spanish Service-Learning Abroad I and II</b></p> <p>Students complete service projects in local schools, hospitals, non-profits, NGOs, and businesses. To the extent possible, students' professional and career interests will be matched with the volunteer site. Students may choose a 3-credit or 6-credit option and volunteer a total of 42 or 120 hours, respectively, in addition to weekly class meetings.</p>	<b>3 credits or 6 credits</b>
<b>Learn</b>	<p><b>SPAN 3151 - Conversation Practicum</b></p> <p>This course combines current event discussion with ongoing conversation practice. Students participate in in-class discussions and debates as well as three weekly language exchange experiences with (1) Spanish university students, (2) local homestay families, and (3) native Spanish senior citizens.</p>	<b>3 credits</b>
	<p><b>SPAN 4693 - Sustainability in Spain</b></p> <p>This course focuses on the economic and environmental dimensions of sustainability studies in the Spanish context. The course includes site visits, field work, and group travel throughout Spain to examine energy, land, and water use as well as examples of sustainable business, architecture, agriculture, and tourism.</p>	<b>3 credits</b>
	<p><b>SPAN 4158 - Social, Cultural, and Linguistic Diversity in Spain</b></p> <p>This course examines the social, cultural, and linguistic dimensions of sustainability and the concepts of diversity and equity in the Spanish context. The course includes field work and group research projects focused on understanding Spain's national and regional identity, its independence and separatist movements, its promotion of co-national languages, and its policies of inclusion/exclusion and social equity/inequity.</p>	<b>3 credits</b>
